Notification of Binding Authority Suspension Modification in Kentucky (Flood)

Effective: Immediately

March 19, 2020

Dear Agency Partner,

Due to potential flooding, effective immediately, binding authority has been suspended for flood property exposures for Nationwide Private Client (underwritten by Crestbrook Insurance Company) for the coverage listed below in the following **additional** Kentucky counties:

Boone, Breckinridge, Bullitt, Campbell, Caldwell, Calloway, Carroll, Crittenden, Daviess, Gallatin, Graves, Hancock, Hardin, Henderson, Jefferson, Kenton, Livingston, Lyon, McCracken, Marshall, Meade, Ohio, Oldham, Trigg, Trimble, Union, Webster

Flood Coverage

Binding authority **remains** suspended for any new flood coverage (Endorsement P8046) as well as any changes to existing flood coverage in the following Kentucky counties:

Ballard, Carlisle, Fulton, Hickman

Please be advised that, while our Policy Issuance system does not restrict the coverage from being selected, **you do not have the authority to bind or modify any flood coverage**. It is important that you make your team aware of the binding restriction to ensure you do not violate the suspension.
